



These terms and conditions are strongly enforced for the 32nd Annual Transcatheter Cardiovascular Therapeutics Conference (“TCT 2020”) by the organizers of the conference, the Cardiovascular Research Foundation (“CRF”).

Badge Changes and/or Reprints

Any on-site badge changes or reprints will incur a **\$125 USD** fee per change/reprint.

Cancellation Policy

- Cancellations received in writing by Wednesday, July 22, 2020 (by 11:59 PM [ET]) will be fully refunded minus a \$100 USD administrative fee.
- Cancellations received in writing between Thursday, July 23, 2020 (12:00 AM [ET]) and Tuesday, August 25, 2020 (11:59 PM [ET]) will be subject to a 50% penalty.
- No refunds will be given after Wednesday, August 26, 2020 (12:00 AM [ET]). Refunds or credits will not be given for a failure to attend, in compensation for any unattended Events, or for early departures.

CRF is not responsible for airfare, hotel, or other costs incurred by participants in the event of program or registration cancellation.

Please note: In the event that TCT 2020 or another Event is abbreviated or cancelled because of circumstances beyond CRF's control (including, but not limited to, civil disturbance; earthquake; electrical outage; explosion; fire; freight embargo; strike or labor unrest; epidemics and/or pandemics; flood, hurricane, tornado, or other acts of God; or an act of war, terrorism, any government [de facto or de jure], or any government agency or official), CRF reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to unilaterally terminate the conference. In these circumstances, the registrant expressly agrees to waive any claim he, she, or it may have against CRF and its agents and assigns for damages or compensation, including but not limited to fees for registration, housing, airfare, and/or incidental charges.

Registration Changes and Cancellations

- Name changes and substitutions are not permitted.

- All attempts will be made to process refunds within 30 business days of cancellation.

Children

Due to the professional nature of the conference, CRF does not allow anyone under 18 years old into the scientific presentations or the Exhibit Hall at any time. Nursing infants (up to 12 months old) will be allowed (a) only if such infants are held at all times; strollers, infant carriers and other portable infant equipment are strictly prohibited; (b) in the Exhibit Hall only during show days (for clarification, infants are never allowed in the Exhibit Hall during set-up or break-down days); and (c) only if a parent has signed a liability waiver. Waivers will be available at the registration desk. Badges will need to reflect that a waiver has been signed. CRF reserves the right to deny or revoke access to any part of the conference to parents, infants and/or children found to be in violation of this policy.

Conference Etiquette

To make the conference experience an enjoyable event for all attendees, please keep the following in mind:

- As a courtesy to our speakers, please refrain from the use of pagers or mobile devices of any kind during presentations. These devices should be powered down or, at a minimum, set to silent.
- Please keep in mind that participants of this conference are in attendance to learn. Therefore, in consideration of all attendees we ask that you please take any conversations outside session rooms.

Group Housing Fee

For groups and exhibiting companies who choose to house in non-official TCT 2020 hotels, an additional fee of \$200 USD per individual within the group will be assessed. Outstanding balances must be paid prior to CRF in order for any badge(s) to be collected.

Identification at Registration

Attendees are required to present a valid photo ID at registration in order to collect registration materials. Unless you are an exhibitor or group who has arranged for an advance group pickup of badges, individuals may only collect their own individual registration. This procedure is in place to protect registration materials from getting lost and to allow CRF to monitor accurate attendance.

Registration materials will not be provided without a photo ID. Furthermore, registrants agree not to allow any other individual to participate in their place at the conference, during the registration process, or any other conference-related activity including acceptance of these terms of registration.

Infant Care Stations

Infant changing stations are located in all restroom facilities.

Limitation of Liability

By registering, you agree to release and hold harmless CRF, its agents and assigns, from all claims, demands, and causes of action arising out of or relating to your participation in TCT 2020 and all TCT 2020 related events, including but not limited to the use of the conference center and lodging facilities.

Loss of Badge Credentials

CRF reserves the rights to revoke or deny attendance of any registered participant, faculty/speaker, exhibitor, or media at TCT 2020 or Event.

Lost and Found

If you lose or find an item, please go to the TCT Staff Office during Event days/hours.

One-Day Passes

- One-Day Passes are only available for purchase by industry professionals and physicians registering individually (please refer to the registration type descriptions for details on who qualifies for these categories). Groups are not eligible to register for One-Day Passes.
- Consecutive One-Day Passes cannot be purchased. Purchase of the One-Day Pass must be made by credit card through the TCT registration website. TCT 2020 will not accept wires or checks for One-Day Passes.
- One-Day Passes will not be printed prior to the selected day of attendance; it is required that holders of the One-Day Pass return it to the designated registration counter on that same day of TCT 2020.
- If the One-Day Pass is not returned before the close of registration on the day of attendance, the credit card on file will **automatically be charged the TCT Full Conference registration rate** for the designated registration category.

Physician & Allied Health Professional Category Verification

Those who register under the physician and allied health professional categories may be subject to further verification by CRF. CRF will reach out directly should additional information be needed.

Post-Event Photography Use Notice

You hereby grant CRF an irrevocable, worldwide, royalty-free, fully paid-up license to reproduce, copy, display, perform, or otherwise use any photos, videos, or audio recordings taken of you by CRF's designated vendor(s) during TCT 2020 or another Event for promotional use (*i.e.*, brochures, association publications, and web-based media such as blogs, websites, e-newsletters). You hereby release and hold harmless CRF and their agents and assigns from all claims, demands, causes of action, and liability related to said use of the material. During TCT 2020, attendees, vendors, speakers/faculty, and others

may be photographed and videotaped by CRF vendors capturing the Event. Some of these photographs or videos may be displayed by CRF in future publications or materials connected with the Event.

Prohibition on Badge Swapping, Sharing, or Lending

Each person attending a CRF -sponsored/-managed meeting, symposia, program, event, etc. (“Event”) will be issued an event-specific badge bearing that person’s name. She or he must have the badge bearing their own name in her or his possession at all times while on the premises at which the Event is taking place. THE SWAPPING, SHARING, OR LENDING OF AN EVENT BADGE TO ANY OTHER PERSON IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED. Anyone found to be wearing a badge that does not bear that person’s name will have the badge immediately confiscated and will be escorted from the premises. Additionally, the attendance privileges of the person whose name appears on the confiscated badge will be revoked and that person will also be escorted from the premises. No replacement badges will be provided, and no refunds will be made, in whole or in part, for confiscated badges.

Violators of this policy (the person to whom the badge was issued, the person found to be in possession of the badge, and where appropriate the company that purchased the badge) may also be banned from attending or participating at any future Event. Additionally, in instances where an exhibiting company is found to have violated this policy, the exhibiting company will be penalized with a reduction in priority points. In cases where CRF is willing to permit a person found to be in violation of this policy to once again have access to the Event, the person or the exhibiting company, as applicable, will be required to re-register and will be charged the full cost of the additional registration. All decisions regarding compliance with or violation of this policy will be made by CRF in CRF’s sole and exclusive discretion.

Recording (Audio, Video, and Still Photography) and Social Media

CRF promotes the free interchange and rapid dissemination of educational content from our meetings. The slides from CRF-sponsored courses are immediately posted on TCTMD.com to facilitate scientific discourse and enhance patient care. Non-flash photography and audio or video recording using hand-held equipment are permitted at all CRF meetings (if not disruptive) for strictly personal, educational, and/or social use. Communicating through social media, including posting brief audio and video clips, is strongly encouraged (respecting embargo rules for late-breaking science). However, it is strictly prohibited to post or live stream entire sessions or live cases (the latter to respect patient privacy) or to use any CRF course content for commercial purposes. Exhibitors may film, record, or photograph activities at their own booth for promotional purposes only with the prior written consent of CRF.

RFID/Beacons

Traffic to and from TCT 2020 session rooms, theaters, the Exhibit Hall, etc. may be captured using radio-frequency identification tags. Registration badges may have a smart label/affixed device that is synced with your registration ID. As you enter and exit various public areas of TCT 2020, your registration information will be captured by electronic readers. The information obtained through this process will be used exclusively by CRF and the TCT Organizational Committee to measure attendance and to analyze aggregated data for our internal business purposes. We may also use this information to send promotional and information communications that we think may be of interest to you. You have the option of requesting that the RFID tag not be attached to your badge at the time you pick up your badge at the Event or at any time by emailing TCT@experient-inc.com. Additionally, if you do not request to have the tag removed, you will later have the option not to receive promotional e-mails from us by using the “unsubscribe” link included in each promotional e-mail.

Scanning

You may be asked to have your badge scanned either at exhibit booths and/or at session rooms. When your badge is scanned by industry supporters and/or sponsors during the meeting, you are opting in to receiving communications from that entity. You will be subject to their communications and privacy policy and must opt out with them directly. We do not endorse, screen, or approve, and are not responsible for their privacy practices.

Sunshine Act

In order to help supporters comply with the Sunshine Act, the names and contact information of all US licensed physicians participating in industry supported functions at TCT 2020 or other Events will be provided to the supporters of that function. The information provided will be used for reporting purposes only as part of the Sunshine Act submission and will appear on the CMS Open Payments website on the next reporting cycle.

Unauthorized Solicitation Policy

Any company or representative of a supplier who is not an exhibitor and is observed to be soliciting business in the Exhibit Hall, in another company's exhibit space, in the aisles of the Exhibit Hall, or in any other area of the conference deemed inappropriate by CRF, will be asked to leave immediately. Unauthorized solicitation in the Exhibit Hall or technical programs is strictly prohibited.

Unsecured Items Policy

Personal belongings such as briefcases, backpacks, purses, coats, book bags, laptops, tablets, or mobile devices should not be left unattended in meeting rooms or public areas. These items are the responsibility of their owner and CRF will not be held responsible for their safekeeping should they become lost or stolen. Additionally, any unattended items may be subject to removal by security upon being discovered.

Wearing Your Badge

For your safety and security, all attendees, faculty/speakers, exhibitors, staff, and suppliers are required to wear their badges to have access to any part of TCT 2020. For safety, please remove your badge when leaving the convention center.

Wire Transfers and Check Payments

Registrations received within the "Early Bird Rate" tier must be paid in full by 11:59 PM (ET) on Thursday, June 11, 2020 or the prevailing rate will be applied to those registrations. Registrations received within the "Advance Rate" tier must be paid in full prior to 11:59 PM (ET) on Wednesday, August 19, 2020 or on-site rates will be applied to those registrations.

A registration is not considered valid until complete payment is received.
